In recognition of his outstanding work, he received CIA's Distinguished Career Intelligence Medal, the George Bush Award for Excellence in Counterterrorism, the Donovan Award (the Clandestine Service's highest honor), and several Director of Central Intelligence Meritorious Unit Citations.

Prior to joining CIA, Mr. Bridges spent five years working for a peacekeeping force in the Middle East. He has been in the financial industry since 2012. Mr. Bridges earned his bachelor's degree with high honors from Dartmouth College and his master's degree from the University of Chicago's Center for Middle Eastern Studies. He speaks five languages.
